Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number.

How to Cite a Chapter in a Printed or Online Book, All Contents Written by the Same Author (s) If you're using information from a chapter of a book where one author or a group of authors equally share credit for all contents of the book, then you just cite the book — there's no need to cite the chapter!

In American Psychological Association style, books are cited both on a separate page of references and in the body of the text. An APA reference page listing requires different information and formatting depending on whether the entire book is written by one author (or authors) or is an edited anthology of chapters by different authors.

Book Chapter References On the other hand, if the chapter comes from a book where each chapter is written by different authors (and the whole thing is put together by an editor), then provide a separate reference for each chapter that you used.

### Books and Book Chapters: What to Cite - APA Style

Narrative citations: Jackson (2019) and Sapolsky (2017) Provide the author, year of publication, title, and publisher of the book. Include any edition information in parentheses after the title, without italics. If the book includes a DOI, include the DOI in the reference after the publisher name.

### Book References - APA Style

Books & eBooks The 7th edition of APA does not differentiate between the format of the books, print or electronic. Cite both the same way. If you have an open-access eBook, you may provide the URL at the end, provided it directly takes you to the full text without logging in.

### Book Examples - APA (7th edition) Citation Guide ...

How to Cite an E-Book Chapter in APA Format. This follows the same structure as an edited book chapter reference except the publisher is exchanged for a URL. The structure is as follows: Last name of the chapter author, initial(s). (Year). Chapter title. In editor initial(s), surname (Ed.). Title (ed., pp.chapter page range). Retrieved from URL

### How to Cite Sources in APA Citation Format - Mendeley

If there are different authors for each chapter, you need to reference EACHchapter you use. If you use multiple chapters from a book with different authors for each chapter, you still need to reference EACH chapter you

use. (This is because you need to acknowledge who wrote the work you are using, not the person who edited/compiled the book).

APA Format Broken Down: Use this format if you are using 1 chapter out of a book that has many chapters, and each chapter is written by a different author. If each chapter is written by the same author, just cite the entire book. Parts of the APA Citation Explanation Author's Last name, First initial.

### **How To Cite a Chapter From a Book in APA Format**

To create a reference for a chapter in an edited book, follow the example for a chapter in an edited book without a DOI. At the end of the reference, after the publisher, add the DOI using the current DOI URL format. The current standard for the DOI begins with "https://doi.org/". Do not add a period after the DOI.
