Add, replace, move, or resize images on the page using selections from the Objects list. Click the other tools to edit your PDF further.

Click the Text button in the Edit tab. Start typing. Drag the box to move text. Choose the black square to select the font color. Click U, B, or I icons when you want to underline text, make it bold or italic.

If you have a copy of Adobe Acrobat (included with most Creative Suite and Creative Cloud subscriptions), you can use it to convert PDF documents to Word format on your Mac or PC. Its conversions are very high quality, and if your PDF document includes pictures with text, it will OCR the text so you can edit it as well.

### **How to Convert & Edit PDF Documents in Microsoft Word**

The Edit Text & Images tool lets you replace, edit, or add text to a PDF. You can correct typos, change fonts and typeface size, adjust alignment, add superscripts or subscripts, and resize text or paragraphs. Open a PDF in Acrobat, and then choose Tools > Edit PDF > Edit. You can edit a PDF one page at a time.

### **How to edit or format text in PDF using Adobe Acrobat**

You can also convert your PDF to a Word document using just Microsoft Word. Converting in Word often leads to style and formatting issues, so it's not always the most reliable method. However, it certainly works well enough for simple documents or when you just need to get stuff into an editable format.

### **How to Convert a PDF to a Microsoft Word Document**

Edit a signed PDF | FAQ. If a PDF is signed using a digital ID or certificate, it's locked to prevent changes to the document. Digital IDs or certificates used to sign PDFs are used for the commercial and legal purpose and are governed by laws in many countries.

### **Edit a signed PDF | FAQ**

In other words, you'll need to destroy what's there and replace it with new content. Depending on complexity and quality of image, this might be a lost cause. Creating a new PSD (Photoshop document) file might be your best option. The idea is to keep separate elements on their own layers so you can go back and edit them later if needed. See screenshot.
