Just to review, Medicare's definition of medical necessity comes in two parts. First, according to the LCD for the Medicare Administrative Contractor, National Government Services (NGS, 2019) for those patients receiving rehabilitative therapy: "...the patient's condition has the potential to improve or is improving in response to therapy, maximum improvement is yet to be attained; and ...

Defensible Documentation: A Framework for Physical Therapy ...

Patients admitted to an inpatient rehabilitation facility (IRF) receive physical therapy treatment under Medicare Part A, which is paid for using a prospective payment system (PPS) methodology. To qualify for Medicare Part A services, a patient must require at least 3 hours of rehabilitation services 5 days per week.

Setting Specific Considerations in Documentation

IRF Documentation Requirements It is expected that patient's medical records reflect the need for care/services provided. The listing of records is not all inclusive. Providers must ensure all necessary records are submitted to support services rendered.

THERAPY CERTIFICATION REQUIRED AS PART OF PLAN OF CARE: Certification requires a dated (physician) signature on the plan of care or some other document that indicates approval of the plan of care "The physician's/NPP's certification of the plan (with or without an order) satisfies all of the certification requirements noted above in §220.1 for the duration of the plan of care, or 90 calendar days from the date of the initial treatment, whichever is less.

Review payer contracts to determine if any payer reimburses based on the rehabilitation MS-DRGs. If so, at least one physical therapy (PT)/occupational therapy (OT) service must be coded for the rehabilitation MS-DRG to be assigned accurately.
