Whenever you open the AC system, you should replace the receiver/drier. It is sensitive to moisture, and replacing it with a fresh one will ensure your AC system works properly. It will always be located close to the condenser. In a miata, it is located through this hole under the plastic in front of the radiator.

Your AC system works the same way, using the cooling effects of expanding gas to chill the air in your cabin. But that gas needs some room to expand, and low pressure to expand into; overcharge the AC system with coolant, and you wind up with a system that acts more like a big oil pump than a nozzle blowing cool, decompressing air into your face.

Signs & Symptoms of an Overcharged AC | It Still Runs

You normally do this when recharging the system after replacing one of the major components. This is tricky. The service manual normally tells you how much refrigerant oil should be added with each major component replaced on the AC system. You need to be very careful during this process.

Most people pay between \$100 and \$350 for a refill, depending on the size and type of your HVAC unit. Older large r22 units can reach \$600 or more. A 25lb jug of r410a runs \$75 to \$175.Labor adds an average \$70 per hour. "Freon" is simply a brand name owned by DuPont chemicals.
